Mikko Macchione has been involved in theater for more than 40 years and theater education for close to 15. He helped develop various summer theater programs - SummerStages and camps at the Contemporary Arts Center and Isidore Newman School. On-stage, he founded the legendary 'mikko presents' series of shows built around themes that played in alternative venues around New Orleans. He has produced shows in both the United States and Mexico, and is a graduate of the National Shakespeare Conservatory.

Gina Phillips, a Kentucky native, has lived in New Orleans since the early '90s. Raised in Madison County, Kentucky, she attended the University of Kentucky, and graduated with a Bachelor of Fine Arts in Painting in 1994. One year later, she moved to New Orleans to pursue a Master of Fine Arts at Tulane University, earning her degree in 1997. Her art has moved from painting to mixed media to works made solely of fabric and thread. She has been a popular resident artist in several of the Ogden Museum's Artists and Sense of Place programs and has taught one of the museum's adult classes, Fiber Arts 101.
